raising awareness for democratic values being core elements of the European identity and its diversity, and at the same time...

through a stronger focus on common visions and projects on art and culture of Western/Central/Eastern/Northern/Southern cultural institutions for various target groups (professional public, general public, young generation, politicians, media, et al.)

taking responsibility through art and culture to respond to the challenges of our times, such as
